15	Section 1. GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONSLIMITATIONS
16	REVERSIONS
17	A. Except as otherwise provided in this section or
18	another section of this act, the unexpended balance of an
19	appropriation made in this act from the general fund shall
20	revert to the originating fund as follows:
21	(1) for projects for which appropriations were
22	made to match federal grants, six months after completion of
23	the project;
24	(2) for projects for which appropriations were
25	made to purchase vehicles, emergency vehicles or other vehicles
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<u>underscored material = new</u> [<del>bracketed material</del>] = delete that require special equipment, heavy equipment, educational technology or equipment or furniture that is not related to a more inclusive construction or renovation project, at the end of the fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in which the appropriation was made for the purchase; and

(3) for all other projects for which appropriations were made, within six months of completion of the project, but no later than the end of fiscal year 2011.

B. Upon certification by an agency that money from the general fund is needed for a purpose specified in this act, the secretary of finance and administration shall disburse such amount of the appropriation for that project as is necessary to meet that need.

C. Except for appropriations to the capital program fund, money from appropriations made in this act shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding written obligations to third parties.
