16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONOne hundred fifty thousand
18	dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
19	Indian affairs department for expenditure in fiscal year 2008
20	to provide case management services to victims of radiation
21	exposure or their surviving families located in New Mexico so
22	that they may access benefits due to them pursuant to the
23	federal Radiation Exposure Compensation Act. Any unexpended or
24	unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2008
25	shall revert to the general fund.
