15	Section 1. Section 22-13-14 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
16	Chapter 16, Section 188, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"22-13-14. EMERGENCY DRILLSREQUIREMENT
18	A. An emergency drill shall be conducted in each
19	public and private school of the state at least once each week
20	during the first four weeks of the school year and at least
21	once each month thereafter until the end of the school year.
22	[Two] <u>One-half of the prescribed</u> drills during the year shall
23	be shelter-in-place drills and one <u>-half</u> shall be [an]
24	evacuation [drill, as] <u>drills for fire or other emergencies,</u>
25	<u>conducted in a manner</u> directed by the department. [The

1	remainder of the drills shall be fire drills. It shall be the
2	responsibility of the person in charge of a school to carry out
3	the provisions of this section.
4	B. In locations where a fire department is
5	maintained, a member of the fire department shall be requested
6	to be in attendance during the emergency drills for the purpose
7	of giving instruction and constructive criticism.]
8	B. Each emergency drill shall be observed by the
9	appropriate authority, including a member of the fire
10	department, a police force with jurisdiction, the federal
11	<u>department of homeland security or any other authority deemed</u>
12	appropriate by the department, for the purpose of giving
13	instruction and constructive criticism.
14	C. The principal of a school or the person acting
15	in a similar capacity is responsible for carrying out the
16	provisions of this section.
17	$[G_{\bullet}]$ <u>D.</u> The department shall determine penalties
18	for any person failing to meet the provisions of this
19	section."
