BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 6-10-36.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1997, Chapter 161, Section 1) is amended to read:

"6-10-36.1. RECEIPTS OF PUBLIC MONEY--DISPOSITION BY

CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES.--[For any] A municipality or village
having within its boundaries no suitable banking facility in
which to deposit collected receipts of public money [such
municipality or village] shall deposit receipts within [a
period not to exceed five] ten days from the date of
collection, excluding a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday;
provided the municipality or village adopts a reasonable
administrative policy approved by the local government division
