BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 3-18-10 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1973, Section 1. Chapter 395, Section 1) is amended to read:

"3-18-10. POWER OF EMINENT DOMAIN--PURPOSES--PROCEEDINGS . --

[Both within the municipal boundary and for a distance not extending beyond the planning and platting jurisdiction of] Within the municipal boundary, a municipality has the power and right of condemnation of private property for public use for the purpose of:

laying out, opening and widening streets, alleys and highways or their approaches; or .164601.1

1	(2) constructing, maintaining and operating:
2	(a) storm drains; or
3	(b) garbage and refuse disposal areas
4	and plants.
5	B. A municipality may acquire by eminent domain any
6	property within the municipality for park purposes.
7	C. A municipality may acquire by eminent domain any
8	property within the municipality to establish cemeteries <u>or</u>
9	mausoleums [or both or combinations thereof] and may also
10	acquire by eminent domain any existing cemeteries <u>or</u> mausoleums
