Section 1. COMMON LAW RULE AGAINST PERPETUITIES

ABROGATED.--The common law rule against perpetuities as it
applies to New Mexico is abrogated.

Section 2. REPEAL.--Sections 45-2-901 through 45-2-906 (being Laws 1992, Chapter 66, Sections 1 through 6, as amended) are repealed.
