18	A. Except as otherwise provided in this section,
19	regular students shall be in school-directed programs,
20	exclusive of lunch, for a minimum of the following:
21	(1) kindergarten, for half-day programs, two
22	and one-half hours per day or four hundred fifty hours per year
23	or, for full-day programs, five and one-half hours per day or
24	[nine hundred ninety] <u>one thousand seventeen and one-half</u> hours

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1 (2) grades one through six, five and one-half 2 hours per day or [nine hundred ninety] one thousand seventeen 3 and one-half hours per year; and 4 (3) grades seven through twelve, six hours per 5 day or one thousand [eighty] one hundred ten hours per year. 6 Β. Thirty-three hours of the full-day kindergarten 7 program may be used for home visits by the teacher or for 8 parent-teacher conferences. Twenty-two hours of grades one 9 through five programs may be used for home visits by the 10 teacher or for parent-teacher conferences. 11 C. Nothing in this section precludes a local school 12 board from setting length of school days in excess of the 13 minimum requirements established by Subsection A of this 14 section. 15 D. The [state superintendent] secretary may waive 16 the minimum length of school days in those districts where such 17 minimums would create undue hardships as defined by the [state 18 board] department." 19 Section 2. Section 22-8-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967, 20 Chapter 16, Section 63, as amended) is amended to read: 21 "22-8-9. 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1 equivalent thereof, exclusive of any release time for in-2 service training; or 3 a variable school year consisting of a (2) minimum number of instructional hours established by the [state 4 5 board] department; and a pupil-teacher ratio or class or teaching 6 (3) 7 load as provided in Section 22-10A-20 NMSA 1978. 8 The [state board] department shall, by rule, Β. 9 establish the requirements for an instructional day, the 10 standards for an instructional hour and the standards for a 11 full-time teacher and for the equivalent thereof." 12 Section 3. APPROPRIATION. -- Sixty-two million dollars 13 (\$62,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the 14 state equalization guarantee distribution of the public school 15 fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2008 to fund the cost of an 16 additional five full instructional days.
