AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO CONTINUE THE WORK OF THE INDIGENOUS NATIONS LIBRARY PROGRAM AT THE GALLUP CAMPUS AND OTHER CAMPUSES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal year 2008 to continue the indigenous nations library program work, including expanding services provided by the tribal information project to all university of New Mexico campuses, especially to the Gallup campus; adding to the Native collections and increasing the information resources at the university of New Mexico libraries; providing information and student assistance for the bachelor's degree in Native American

1 studies; developing information-seeking and research skills of
2 Native American students and increasing the success and
3 retention of the university's Native American students. Any
4 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
5 fiscal year 2008 shall revert to the general fund.
