20	Section 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSE ACCOUNTLOW-INTEREST
21	LOANS FOR ACTIVE DUTY ARMED FORCES MEMBERS AND THEIR SPOUSES
22	-Appropriations, grants, donations and bequests may be made in

members of the armed forces of the United States serving on active duty or to their spouses. The secretary of veterans' services shall deposit the money in a temporary suspense account for distribution, in the form of low-interest loans, to New Mexico residents who are members of the armed forces of the United States serving on active duty or to their spouses who demonstrate to the veterans' services department on a form prescribed by that department that the member is serving on active duty.

Section 2. APPROPRIATION. --Five million dollars (\$5,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the temporary suspense account designated in Section 1 of this act for expenditure in fiscal year 2007 to provide low-interest loans to New Mexico residents who are members of the armed forces of the United States who are serving on active duty and to their spouses. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2007 shall revert to the general fund.
