20	A. "essential parts" means all integral and body
21	parts of a vehicle of a type required to be registered by the

"established place of business", for a dealer or auto recycler, means a place: 2 devoted exclusively to the business for 3 (1)which the dealer or auto recycler is licensed and related 4 5 business: (2)identified by a prominently displayed 6 sign giving the dealer's or auto recycler's trade name used by 7 the business: 8 of sufficient size or space to permit the 9 (3) 10 display of one or more vehicles or to permit the parking or storing of vehicles to be dismantled or wrecked for recycling; 11 on which there is located an enclosed 12 (4) building on a permanent foundation, which building meets the 13 building requirements of the community and is large enough to 14 accommodate the office or offices of the dealer or auto 15 recycler and large enough to provide a safe place to keep the 16 books and records of the dealer or auto recycler; 17 (5) where the principal portion of the 18 business of the dealer or auto recycler is conducted and where 19 the books and records of the business are kept and maintained; 20 and 21 where vehicle sales are of new vehicles (6) 22 only, such as a department store or a franchisee of a 23 department store, as long as the department store or 24 franchisee keeps the books and records of its vehicle business 25 . 164348. 2

in a general office location at its place of business; as used in this paragraph, "department store" means a business that offers a variety of merchandise other than vehicles, and sales of the merchandise other than vehicles constitute at least eighty percent of the gross sales of the business; [and]

C. "event data recorder" means a device installed in a motor vehicle by its manufacturer for the purpose of retrieving information about the operation of the motor vehicle, including data relating to speed, direction, location, functioning, performance and use of safety devices in the motor vehicle; and

[C.-] D. "explosives" means any chemical compound or mechanical mixture that is commonly used or intended for the purpose of producing an explosion and that contains any oxidizing and combustive units or other ingredients in such proportions, quantities or packing that an ignition by fire, friction, concussion, percussion or detonator of any part of the compound or mixture may cause such a sudden generation of highly heated gases that the resultant gaseous pressures are capable of producing destructive effects on contiguous objects or of destroying life or limb."

Section 2. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is enacted to read:
