20	and youth violence prevention agencies as well as similar
21	organizations in the Native American community to attend a
22	two-week training program and earn credentials for the
23	treatment of sexually abusive youth. Each agency that
24	provides adolescent sex offender therapy shall be encouraged
25	to send a therapist to the two-week training program, and
