AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO ESTABLISH PROGRAMS AND SERVICES FOR JAILED AND INCARCERATED PARENTS AND THEIR CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO: Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Three million three hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$3,320,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal year 2008 in the following amounts and for the following purposes:

(\$2,600,000) to contract with community-based providers to work within local detention facilities to link children and their caretakers to resources and to facilitate communication and visitation between jailed and incarcerated parents and their .166696.1

- five hundred twenty thousand dollars (2) (\$520,000) to contract with four detention facilities to develop and implement contact visitation programs between jailed and incarcerated parents and their children; and
- two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) (3) for equipment to establish videoconferencing capability between the children, youth and families department and corrections department detention facilities.
- Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert to the general fund.
