AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC ASSISTANCE; PROVIDING FOR MEDICAID
REIMBURSEMENT AT THE MEDICARE PART B RATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 27-2-12.3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987,
Chapter 269, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"27-2-12.3. MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENT--EQUAL PAY FOR EQUAL
PHYSICIANS', DENTISTS', OPTOMETRISTS', PODIATRISTS' AND
PSYCHOLOGISTS' SERVICES.--

A. The human services department shall establish a
rate, of not less than the rate for medicare part B services,
for the reimbursement of physicians, dentists, optometrists,
podiatrists and psychologists for services rendered to medicaid
fee-for-service or managed care patients that provides equal
reimbursement for the same or similar services rendered without

12 B. On July 1, 2008 and on July 1 of each subsequent
13 year, the human services department shall increase the
14 reimbursement rate established pursuant to Subsection A of this
15 section. In determining the annual percentage increase, the
16 department shall take into consideration factors that affect
17 the cost of providing services, including increases in medical
18 liability premiums and office overhead.

19 C. All reimbursements for fee-for-service and
20 managed care services shall include the gross receipts taxes
21 paid."

22 Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
23 provisions of this act is July 1, 2007.
