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1 counseling; individual or group therapy; day or partial-day 2 programming activities such as psychosocial rehabilitation; 3 medication; alcohol or substance abuse treatment and 4 counseling; crisis supports; and supportive housing or other 5 supervised living arrangements. The department may purchase 6 services from a single behavioral health entity or provide the 7 services directly or contract with another qualified provider 8 to provide the services directly, and the department may use 9 some of the appropriation to provide matching funds for the 10 medicaid program on behalf of persons who meet eligibility 11 criteria as set forth above.
