AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL FINANCE; ESTABLISHING A HOME SCHOOL STUDENT ACTIVITIES PROGRAM UNIT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-8-18 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1974, Chapter 8, Section 8, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-8-18. PROGRAM COST CALCULATION--LOCAL RESPONSIBILITY.--

A. The total program units for the purpose of computing the program cost shall be calculated by multiplying the sum of the program units itemized as Paragraphs (1) through (5) in this subsection by the instructional staff training and experience index and adding the program units itemized as Paragraphs (6) through [\(\frac{(10)}{10}\)] (11) in this subsection. The itemized program units are as follows:

1	(1) early childhood education;
2	(2) basic education;
3	(3) special education, adjusted by subtracting
4	the units derived from membership in class D special education
5	programs in private, nonsectarian, nonprofit training centers;
6	(4) bilingual multicultural education;
7	(5) fine arts education;
8	(6) size adjustment;
9	(7) at-risk program;
10	(8) enrollment growth or new district
11	adjustment;
12	(9) special education units derived from
13	membership in class D special education programs in private,
14	nonsectarian, nonprofit training centers; [and]
15	(10) national board for professional teaching
16	standards certification; and
17	(11) home school student activities.
18	B. The total program cost calculated as prescribed
19	in Subsection A of this section includes the cost of early
20	childhood, special, bilingual multicultural, fine arts and
21	vocational education and other remedial or enrichment programs.
22	It is the responsibility of the local school board or governing
23	body of a charter school to determine its priorities in terms
24	of the needs of the community served by that board. Funds
25	generated under the Public School Finance Act are discretionary

to local school boards and governing bodies of charter schools, provided that the special program needs as enumerated in this section are met."

Section 2. A new section of the Public School Finance Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] HOME SCHOOL STUDENT ACTIVITIES PROGRAM
UNIT.--The home school student activities program unit for a
school district is determined by multiplying the number of home
school students who are participating in school district
activities governed by the New Mexico activities association by
the cost differential factor of 0.1. The home school student
activities program unit shall be paid to the school district in
which it is generated. A home school student is eligible to
participate in school district activities at the public school
in the attendance zone in which the student resides, according
to the New Mexico activities association guidelines. If the
student chooses to participate at a public school other than
the one in the attendance zone in which the student resides,
the student shall be subject to New Mexico activities
association transfer guidelines."
