13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
14	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONFive hundred thousand dollars
15	(\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
16	governor's office for expenditure in fiscal year 2008 to
17	contract for a comprehensive study of the economic,
18	environmental and fiscal impacts of shifting New Mexico over
19	the next two decades from a system of taxing desirable
20	activities such as income, work, property and purchasing
21	products and services to a progressive system of taxing
22	undesirable activities such as waste, pollution and the use of
23	non-renewable resources. Any unexpended or unencumbered
24	balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert
25	to the general fund.
