Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert to the appropriation contingency fund.

After a certification is made pursuant to this section, the interstate stream commission shall report monthly to the secretary of finance and administration and the legislative finance committee regarding the amount of money expended and encumbered, the specific contracts executed and the overall progress toward implementation of the Pecos River Compact settlement.
