by regulation of the commission, such regulation to provide for a staggered system of license expiration and for SB 297

proration of fees for licenses issued for less than a full year. Thereafter, such licenses shall be issued for a period of two years or as otherwise provided by the division pursuant to Subsection B of this section. Licenses shall be subject to renewal upon application to the division and payment of the prescribed renewal fee.

Licensees and journeyman certificate holders 7 D. may be required to complete and submit proof of continuing 8 education as a prerequisite for renewal of a license. 9 When 10 required by rule adopted by the division, an applicant for a license renewal must submit with the application for license 11 renewal proof of eight hours of instruction in code change 12 and eight hours of instruction in other industry-related and 13 division-approved subjects. The sixteen hours of continuing 14 15 education must have been completed within the three years prior to the date of the license renewal application. 16

E. The director shall, at least thirty days prior to the expiration date of a license, notify the licensee of the approaching expiration. Notice shall be given by mail addressed to the licensee's last address on file with the division. The notice shall include a renewal application form, instructions and any other information prescribed by the division.

F. Failure of a licensee to make application forthe renewal of the licensee's license, to furnish such other SB 297

4	suspended by operation of law.	
5	G. Unless the license is renewed within a
