9	A. A person shall not knowingly or willfully
10	deface or destroy, in whole or in part, a descanso, also
11	known as a memorial, placed alongside a public road right of
12	way to memorialize the death of one or more persons.
13	B. A person who violates the provisions of
14	Subsection A of this section is:
15	(l) for a first offense, guilty of a petty
16	misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be sentenced pursuant
17	to the provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA 1978; and
18	(2) for a second and subsequent offense,
19	guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be
20	sentenced pursuant to the provisions of Section 31-19-1 NMSA
21	1978.
22	C. The provisions of this section shall not apply

to law enforcement officials or other employees of the state

or a political subdivision of the state who in the course of

the lawful discharge of their duties move or remove a
