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7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:	
8	Section 1. A new section of the Motor Vehicle Code is	
9	enacted to read:	
10	"ADVANCE SIGNAL WARNING REQUIRED	
11	A. As used in this section:	
12	(1) "camera monitor" means a device or	
13	instrument that records a visual image of a motor vehicle	
14	being operated in violation of a traffic signal's red light	
15	directive to stop;	
16	(2) "controller assembly" means a complete	
17	electrical device mounted in a cabinet for controlling the	
18	operation of a traffic signal;	
19	(3) "rumble strips" means grooves in	
20	pavement or rows of raised pavement markers placed	
21	perpendicular to the direction of travel in a street or	
22	highway lane to alert inattentive drivers to a lane or	
23	traffic condition;	
24	(4) "traffic signal" means a power-operated	
25	traffic control device by which traffic is alternately	SB 861 Page l

directed to stop and permitted to proceed; and

(5) "warning beacon" means a power-operated traffic control device with one or more signal sections that operates in a flashing mode.

When a county or municipality, including a 5 Β. 6 home-rule municipality that has adopted a charter pursuant to Article 10, Section 6 of the constitution of New Mexico, uses 7 a camera monitor in conjunction with a traffic signal at an 8 intersection or other location to detect violation of the 9 10 traffic signal's red light directive to stop, the county or municipality shall install, on streets or highways 11 approaching the traffic signal from directions covered by the 12 camera monitor, a warning sign or signs supplemented by a 13 warning beacon or rumble strips. 14

15 C. The warning beacon described in Subsection B of this section shall be installed, together with the warning 16 sign or signs, at a location and interconnected with the 17 traffic signal controller assembly in a manner that will 18 cause the beacon to flash yellow during the period when a 19 20 person driving a motor vehicle passing the beacon at the legal speed for the street or highway will encounter a 21 traffic signal red light, or a queue of motor vehicles 22 resulting from the display of the red light, upon arrival at 23 the signalized location. 24

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D. If rumble strips described in Subsection B of SB 861

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this section are used, they shall be installed, together with warning signs, at a location in advance of a traffic signal so as to provide a driver, moving over the rumble strips at the legal speed for the street or highway, with warning that if the traffic signal is displaying a yellow signal, the driver will encounter a traffic signal red light, or a queue of motor vehicles resulting from the display of the red light, upon arrival at the signalized location.

Warning signs used with beacons or rumble 9 Ε. strips shall warn a driver that the driver may encounter a 10 traffic signal displaying a red light at an upcoming 11 intersection and that the traffic signal is photo-enforced. 12 When used with rumble strips, a warning sign shall be 13 installed facing traffic approaching a signalized location on 14 15 the near side of the street or highway and, if appropriate, a warning sign shall also be installed facing traffic 16 approaching a signalized location on a median dividing 17 opposite directions of traffic. 18

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
