A MEMORIAL

RECOGNIZING THE CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE NATIONAL DEFENSE MADE BY
THE FOUR MAJOR ACTIVE DEFENSE INSTALLATIONS IN THE STATE OF
NEW MEXICO ALONG WITH THE RESERVE FORCE CAPABILITY OF THE NEW
MEXICO NATIONAL GUARD.

WHEREAS, New Mexico is the home of four major department of defense military bases, including Cannon air force base in Clovis, Holloman air force base in Alamogordo, Kirtland air force base in Albuquerque and White Sands missile range near Las Cruces, and is also supported by the men and women of the New Mexico national guard, including the air national guard and army national guard; and

WHEREAS, the total economic impact within New Mexico of the four installations exceeds five billion dollars (\$5,000,000,000); and

WHEREAS, the installations have missions critical to the national defense of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the installations' major missions include tactical air, test and evaluation, research and development, special operations training, counterterrorism and other critical areas, along with a host of secondary missions; and

WHEREAS, the most important single element in these department of defense installations and the New Mexico national guard is people, whether uniformed men and women,

family members, civilians working for the individual armed forces, contractors and others associated with each military installation in the state, along with the New Mexico national guard men and women; and

WHEREAS, the state of New Mexico is known for its support of the military; and
