10	"new town" was established; and	
11	WHEREAS, Las Vegas was one of the largest cities in the	
12	southwest and host to its own opera house, a college, a	
13	Harvey House hotel and a Carnegie library; and	
14	WHEREAS, Las Vegas hosted a reunion of Teddy Roosevelt's	
15	rough riders, the earliest recorded rodeo and many colorful	
16	western characters and events; and	
17	WHEREAS, Las Vegas is a city rich with history and	
18	tradition;	
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE	
20	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that March 9, 2007 be declared "Las
