SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 502 appropriates \$121,795,300 from the general fund to state equalization guarantee distribution of the public school fund to provide an average 8 percent salary increase for licensed school employees in the 2007-2008 year.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$121,795,300 contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY08 shall revert to the general fund.
