## SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill
Senate Bill 149 appropriates $\$ 100.0$ from the general fund to the Department of Military Affairs - Crisis Response Program for the purpose of providing a drug demand reduction program through the civil air patrol cadet program for at-risk middle and high school students.
