### **SUMMARY**

### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 654 amends Section 60-6A-15 (N), licensing fees for club licenses. For clubs with any amount of members the fee would be \$250. The current statute charges two rates depending on how many member a club has. For clubs with two hundred fifty members or fewer, the current fee is two hundred fifty dollars (\$250). For clubs with more than two hundred fifty members, the current fee is one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1250). SB 654 would amend the Liquor Control Act so that "ALL" club licenses would pay \$250 for license renewal annually.

### **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

Currently New Mexico has 159 club licenses. Sixty percent of these licenses pay \$1250 annually to renew their licenses. If SB 654 were enacted the State of NM would lose approximately \$95,000 to the General Fund.

### SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The Regulation and Licensing Department is concerned their revenue would decrease with Senate Bill 654.
