## **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

DFA commented that a statewide fly-over funded by a combination of local, state, and federal funding was done in 2005. The goal is to do the entire state every five years. DFA reports that the bill's appropriation of \$980.0 is excessive and that it could be done for less than \$100.0. According to DFA, the last statewide aerial fly-over cost \$3.5 million for the entire state.
