Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 849 appropriates \$300 thousand from the general fund to the Public Education Department for middle school reading programs in the Taos municipal school district.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$300 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2008 shall revert to the general fund.
