WHEREAS, the cost of providing Iaw enf orcement services in the border regi ons of New Mexico is increasing due to i mingration issues; and

WHEREAS, i mingation control and border security are federal issues, the cost of which should be borne by the federal government; and

WHEREAS, New Mexi co bears a di sproportionate financial burden because of its location as a border state;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGI SLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXI CO that the United States congress be urged to provi de greater funding to New Mexi co to offset the additional demands placed on this state by virtue of its status as a border state; and
