REQUESTING THE NEW MEXICO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO CREATE AN INTERIM COMMITTEE OR ASSIGN AN APPROPRIATE INTERIM COMMITTEE TO REVIEW OPTIONS FOR AMENDING THE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS RETIREMENT ACT.

WHEREAS, as volunteers, these people, unlike career firefighters, do not qualify for retirement programs through their local governments; and

WHEREAS, the volunteer firefighter retirement program can assist local fire departments in the recruiting and retention of personnel; and

credit, calculating benefits and removing inactive members from the retirement database;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to appoint an interim committee or assign an appropriate interim committee to study the provisions of the Volunteer Firefighters Retirement Act and consider necessary amendments to the act; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the public employees retirement association, the state fire marshal's office, the fire service council, the New Mexico municipal league and the New Mexico association of counties be consulted during the interim study; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the legislative council service for distribution to the New Mexico legislative council.
