23	means of transfers on death deeds; and
24	WHEREAS, exemptions from the New Mexico Subdivision Act do
25	not currently include a requirement of documentation that all

WHEREAS, precise definitions of terms are necessary to implement the New Mexico Subdivision Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to direct the appropriate interim legislative committee to study the New Mexico Subdivision Act, including review of the state's statutes relating to exemptions allowed in the act, the transfer of deeds upon death, tax and assessment obligations and definition of terms; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the interim legislative committee report its findings and recommendations for legislation to the second session of the forty-eighth legislature; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the members of the New Mexico legislative council.
