NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the pilot project for on-site child care at the New Mexico department of transportation run by Kids Under Konstruction, a nonprofit corporation created and managed by employees of the department, be recognized as a valuable project for the state of New Mexico; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to direct the appropriate legislative interim committee to examine the issues of child care as they relate to state employees and the citizens of New Mexico; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appropriate legislative interim committee be requested to examine methods to foster nonprofit partnerships with state government to provide on-site child care to state government employees and to the citizens of .167758.1
