WHEREAS, public safety and rehabilitation efforts are compromised in the absence of adequate resources for the adult probation and parole division;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico sentencing commission be requested to research issues related to providing adult probation and parole services to offenders in New Mexico; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the research conducted by the New Mexico sentencing commission include the following issues:

A. caseloads for adult probation and parole officers;

B. national standards for caseloads;

C. starting salaries for adult probation and parole officers;

D. competing salaries for similar employment in New Mexico;

E. retention of adult probation and parole officers; and

F. the number of vacant officer positions within the adult probation and parole division; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the New Mexico sentencing commission report its findings to the appropriate interim .168240.1
