or telecommunications allowances or easy access to research libraries and materials; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico legislative council has appointed a legislative structure and process study task force to examine a range of legislative reforms that might allow the legislature to fulfill its duties more effectively; and

WHEREAS, establishing legislative council service field offices around the state might provide legislators more convenient and ready access to the professional and support staff services necessary to fulfill their legislative duties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the legislative structure and process study task force be requested to study the feasibility of providing legislative council service field offices around the state and report its recommendations and findings, if any, on this issue with its full recommendations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the co-chairs of the legislative structure and process study task force.
