21	southwest and host to its own opera house, a college, a Harvey
22	House hotel and a Carnegie library; and
23	WHEREAS, Las Vegas hosted a reunion of Teddy Roosevelt's
24	rough riders, the earliest recorded rodeo and many colorful
25	western characters and events; and
