WHEREAS, the state benefits greatly from preservation of the traditional acequia system; and

WHEREAS, agricultural producers and the acequias will benefit greatly from improved methods of agricultural water use: and

WHEREAS, without conservation of water, the economy, lifestyle, environment and agricultural traditions of the state of New Mexico are in jeopardy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF 10 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the interstate stream commission and office of the state engineer, in 12 conjunction with the New Mexico department of agriculture and agricultural producers, undertake those studies necessary to document methods and practices that can result in less use of agricultural water while maintaining, increasing or improving agricultural production and economics; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the interstate stream commission, the state engineer and the New Mexico department of agriculture report their findings to the appropriate committee of the legislature appointed by the New Mexico legislative council to review this issue; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the chair of the interstate stream commission, the state engineer and the director of the New Mexico department of agriculture.
