23	WHEREAS, the administrative office of the courts, the
24	administrative office of the district attorneys and the New
25	Mexico association of counties met and developed

WHEREAS, the counties and the state would benefit from further discussion on the topic of security personnel and whether the state should take over more of the funding of the facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the administrative office of the courts, the administrative office of the district attorneys and the New Mexico association of counties be requested to have further discussion on the topic of security personnel and facility funding and to develop recommendations from these discussions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the administrative office of the courts, the administrative office of the district attorneys and the New Mexico association of counties report their findings to the appropriate legislative interim committee no later than November 30, 2007; and
