11	REQUESTING THAT A WORK GROUP BE ASSEMBLED TO EVALUATE WHAT
12	EFFECTS MAY EXIST FROM AERIAL APPLICATIONS MADE TO AGRONOMIC
13	CROPS NEAR SCHOOLS.

15	WHEREAS, agriculture is historically and economically
16	important to New Mexico and its citizens and communities; and
17	WHEREAS, New Mexico's children must be provided with a
18	safe place to obtain an education; and
19	WHEREAS, schools may be located in an agricultural
20	community; and
21	WHEREAS, various plant protectants and nutrients are
22	applied to agronomic crops; and
23	WHEREAS, children are developing and growing during their
24	school years and spend one-third of each day of the school year
25	in or on school grounds; and

WHEREAS, children's exposure to chemicals or toxins that may trigger asthmatic or chemical sensitivity reactions should be minimized; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico department of agriculture has regulatory authority over plant protectants and nutrients applied to agronomic crops; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico has an agricultural aviation association that represents the aerial applicators in the state of New Mexico;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the director of the New Mexico department of agriculture be requested to assemble a work group to evaluate what effects may exist from aerial applications made to agronomic crops near schools and formulate precautionary actions to ensure that children are not being exposed to the products used in aerial applications during school hours; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the work group consist of a representative of the department of health, the department of environment, the public education department, the aerial applicator industry, the tools for schools good neighbor program and a local school district and any other members the director feels will add value to the work product; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the director report on the progress of the work group to the appropriate interim legislative committee no later than November 1, 2007; and .168781.1
