20	and federal lawmakers have called for a congressional
21	investigation into the agents' prosecutions; and
22	WHEREAS, other developments in the case are that the union
23	representing most rank-and-file border patrol agents
24	established a legal defense fund for the agents, that civilian
25	border watch groups have asked the United States attorney
