The vote on the final report of the committee on each bill, memorial or resolution referred to it shall be taken by yeas and nays and entered upon the records of the committee and shall be shown upon the report of the committee for such bill, memorial or resolution. A vote on any motion that concludes a committee's consideration of a bill, memorial or resolution and that does not cause a final report to be issued shall be shown in another report if a roll call vote was taken on the motion.".
