AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR RECRUITMENT AND TRAINING OF
UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS FOR PREPARATION IN HEALTH CARE CAREERS
SERVING RURAL AND UNDERSERVED AREAS OF THE STATE AT NEW
MEXICO'S SMALLER UNIVERSITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university for expenditure in fiscal year 2009 to establish a demonstration and research program that will better prepare undergraduate students from small universities for successful entry into medical school or other related health fields. This includes a focused undergraduate curriculum, summer science academies, remote learning, medical school entrance examination

preparation and mentoring by rural physicians and physicians associated with the New Mexico Hispanic medical association.

Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2009 shall revert to the general fund.
