23	liability of the surety for all claims shall be limited to the
24	face amount of the bond irrespective of the number of years the

1 F. Proof of responsibility posted by a licensee or 2 applicant shall be in a form to provide thirty days' written 3 notice of a cancellation to the division. 4 G. Failure to maintain proof of responsibility for 5 the period required by law is cause for revocation of the 6 license. 7 H. No legal action may be maintained on the proof 8 of responsibility unless the action is commenced within twelve 9 months after the case accrues or within twelve months after 10 substantial completion of the project, whichever is earlier. 11 I. If a licensee's license bond or cash collateral 12 assignment is canceled, expires or otherwise becomes 13 ineffective during the period for which it is required, the 14 division shall cancel the license upon receiving notice of such 15 cancellation, expiration or ineffectiveness. The cancellation 16 of the license shall become effective thirty days after the 17 date that notice of such action is mailed to the licensee by 18 the division, unless the licensee provides to the division 19 within that thirty days proof of responsibility as required 20 under this section. A person whose license has been canceled 21 pursuant to this subsection may be renewed or reinstated 22 provided he complies with all licensing requirements. 23 J. 2	B. Proof of responsibility shall be a bond of ten
3	thousand dollars (\$10,000) acceptable to the director and
4	underwritten by a corporate surety authorized to transact
5	business in New Mexico. Such bond shall meet the following
6	conditions:
7	(1) payments from a bond required pursuant to
8	this section may only be used to cure code violations caused by
9	a licensee, certified by the division and not corrected by the
10	licensee. Claims against the bond shall be made within two
11	years following final inspection or within two years of
12	issuance of a certificate of occupancy for the construction
13	project, whichever is earlier;
14	(2) the total aggregate liability of the
15	surety for all claims shall be limited to the face amount of
16	the bond;
17	(3) the bond carrier shall provide to the
18	division and to the licensee thirty days' prior written notice
19	of intent to cancel a bond required pursuant to this section.
20	The surety for such a bond shall remain liable under the
21	provisions of the bond for all obligations of the principal
22	pertaining to bond terms that occur before the bond is
23	canceled, expires or otherwise becomes ineffective;

3	otherwise becomes ineffective during the period of a license,
4	the division shall suspend the affected license for a period
5	not to exceed thirty days and shall notify the license holder

8	the license shall be subject to revocation for failure of proof
9	of responsibility."
