16	Section 1. APPROPRIATION
17	A. Nine million two hundred seventy-eight thousand
18	dollars (\$9,278,000) is appropriated from the general fund to
19	the children, youth and families department for expenditure in
20	fiscal year 2009 as follows:
21	(1) two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the
22	aim high program and the stars program to increase the quality
23	of early child care programs;
24	(2) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for
25	scholarships to help early childhood teachers study child

2	(3) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for a
3	pilot program of education and retention incentives for early
4	childhood teachers, based on the educational levels those

8	services for working families with children from birth to five
9	years of age;
10	(5) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to
11	implement inclusive child care; and
12	(6) seventy-eight thousand dollars (\$78,000)
13	for child care resources and referrals.
14	B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
15	at the end of fiscal year 2009 shall revert to the general
