19	continue the work of the task force created in the 2007
20	legislative session by House Memorial 41 and Senate Joint
21	Memorial 4 to review barriers to public employment for persons
22	with criminal convictions and to:
23	(1) review current clearance regulations for
24	all state agencies and local public bodies and make
25	recommendations;
