15	Section 1. FIREFIGHTERSREBUTTAL PRESUMPTION OF CAUSE OF
16	DISEASE, DISABILITY OR DEATH
17	A. For the purpose of workers' compensation
18	matters, occupational disease matters and the public employees
19	retirement association, the following diseases, if diagnosed in
20	a firefighter, are presumed to be proximately caused by the
21	employment of the firefighter; provided that this presumption
22	shall not apply to a firefighter who was diagnosed with the
23	disease prior to employment as a firefighter. Disability or
24	death of a firefighter caused by the following diseases unless
25	diagnosed prior to employment are presumed to result from
