11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY
12 FAMILIES PROGRAMS ON TRIBAL LANDS.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--

16 A. One million five hundred thousand dollars
17 (\$1,500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the human
18 services department for expenditure in fiscal year 2009 for
19 supporting temporary assistance for needy families programs on
20 tribal lands, to be distributed as follows:

21 (1) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for
22 Navajo Nation programs supporting temporary assistance for
23 needy families programs; and

24 (2) five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000)
25 for Pueblo of Zuni tribal programs supporting temporary
