AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR PROGRAMS, EDUCATION AND RESEARCH RELATING TO SPINAL CORD-RELATED PARALYSIS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the governor's commission on disability for expenditure in fiscal year 2009 for programs, education and research relating to improvements for spinal cord-related paralysis, or transverse myelitis, through contracts with a regional not-for-profit organization that can provide therapeutic programming and education, and to encourage research, to be distributed as follows:

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) (1) to increase disability-friendly recreation and tourism and .171450.1

- (2) eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) to organize and administer a conference promoting medical cooperation and research on paralysis through a regional symposium; and
