14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. Section 17-1-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1921,
16	Chapter 35, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"17-1-2. STATE GAME COMMISSIONAPPOINTMENTTERM
18	<u>A.</u> To carry out the purpose of Chapter 17 NMSA 1978
19	and all other acts for like purpose, there is created a "state
20	game commission" of [ <del>seven</del> ] <u>eight</u> members, not more than four
21	of whom shall be of the same political party at the time of
22	their appointment. The members of the commission shall be
23	appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the
24	senate. The term of office for each member of the commission
25	shall be four years. At the time of making the first

1 appointments, the governor shall designate the commissioners' 2 terms as being one, two, three or four years so that the term 3 of no more than two commissioners shall expire each year. 4 B. In making appointments to the state game 5 commission, one member shall be appointed from each of the 6 following districts: 7 [A.] (1) district one: Curry, De Baca, 8 Roosevelt, Chaves, Lincoln, Otero, Eddy and Lea counties; 9 [B.] (2) district two: Catron, Socorro, 10 Grant, Hidalgo, Luna, Sierra and Dona Ana counties; 11 [<del>C.</del>] (3) district three: San Juan, McKinley, 12 Cibola, Valencia, Sandoval, Los Alamos and Rio Arriba counties; 13 [D.] (4) district four: Santa Fe, Taos, 14 Colfax, Union, Mora, Harding, Quay, San Miguel, Guadalupe and Torrance counties; and 15 16 [E.] (5) district five: Bernalillo county. 17 The remaining [two] three members shall be appointed at-large. 18 At least one member of the commission shall manage and operate 19 a farm or ranch that contains at least two species of wildlife 20 on that part [which] that is deeded land requiring licensing 21 prior to legal pursuit under the provisions of Section 17-3-2 22 NMSA 1978. At least one member shall have a demonstrated 23 history of involvement in wildlife and habitat protection 24 issues and [whose] have activities or occupation [are] not in 25 conflict with wildlife and habitat advocacy.
