AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT TO IMPROVE QUALITY AND PROVIDE SUPPORT FOR CHILD CARE PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

- Nine million two hundred seventy-eight thousand dollars (\$9,278,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal year 2009 as follows:
- two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the (1) aim high program and the stars program to increase the quality of early child care programs;
- one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for (2) scholarships to help early childhood teachers study child .171613.1

- (5) one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to implement inclusive child care; and
- (6) seventy-eight thousand dollars (\$78,000) for child care resources and referrals.
- B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2009 shall revert to the general fund.
