16	Section 1. A new section of the Controlled Substances Act
17	is enacted to read:
18	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] CONSUMPTION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE
19	WHILE PREGNANT
20	A. Consumption of a controlled substance while
21	pregnant consists of knowingly and intentionally:
22	(1) consuming a controlled substance, the
23	possession of which is prohibited pursuant to the Controlled
24	Substances Act, when the person knows or should know that she
25	is pregnant; or
