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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. Section 9-15-4.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,
17	Chapter 97, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"9-15-4.1. GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON FILM AND MEDIA

20	A. The "governor's council on film and media
21	industries" is created to advise the department and the
22	governor on ways to promote film production in New Mexico,
23	assist in the design and implementation of the department's
24	strategic plan for building a media infrastructure in the
25	state, assist in designing a workforce training program for

film production and make recommendations for incentives and
 funding for these efforts.

B. The governor's council on film and media
industries shall be composed of no more than thirty members
appointed by the governor for [four-year] two-year staggered
terms; provided that the initial appointments shall be made so
that one-half of the members shall be appointed for two-year
terms and one-half of the members shall be appointed for fouryear terms. Terms shall expire on January 1.

C. From the membership of the governor's council on film and media industries, the governor shall appoint a sevenmember "executive board". At least five members of the executive board shall have experience in some aspect of film production. The executive board shall:

(1) with the approval of the secretary, create subcommittees of the governor's council on film and media industries and name the [chairmen] chairs of those subcommittees;

(2) coordinate activities of the subcommitteesand the governor's council on film and media industries; and

(3) develop recommendations pertaining to the charges of the governor's council on film and media industries for the consideration of the governor's council on film and media industries.

D. The governor shall name the [chairman] <u>chair</u> of .171511.1

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1 the governor's council on film and media industries, who shall 2 serve as the [chairman] chair of the executive board. The 3 governor's council on film and media industries may elect such 4 other officers as it deems necessary. The governor's council 5 on film and media industries shall meet at the call of the 6 [chairman] chair, at least quarterly. Members of the 7 governor's council on film and media industries may receive per 8 diem and mileage for travel within New Mexico as provided in 9 the Per Diem and Mileage Act, but shall receive no other 10 compensation, perquisite or allowance.

E. Staff for the governor's council on film and media industries shall be provided by the department.

F. The governor's council on film and media industries shall report to the department, the governor and the legislature by December 1 of each year on its activities and recommendations."

Section 2. TEMPORARY PROVISION--TERMS.--Notwithstanding the term-length amendment to Section 9-15-4.1 NMSA 1978 in this 2008 act, the terms of members appointed in 2007 shall expire on January 1, 2010.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is January 1, 2009.

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
